If your child does not need to be picked up, then please call BIHS at (760) 872-3911 to make sure that the bus driver is aware that they do not need to come by and pick them up that morning.

NO Vehicle Idling in The BIHS Parking Lot

Idling refers to running a vehicle's engine when the vehicle is not in motion. This commonly occurs when drivers are stopped at a red light, waiting while parked outside a business or residence, or otherwise stationary with the engine running. When this is happening, your vehicle emits poisonous toxins that are released into the air. These toxins are unsafe to breathe and are an environmental hazard. Plus, when your vehicle is idling you are wasting gas!
