Eligibility Requirements:

1. I am age 15-24 on the day of the contest.
2. I am female and an enrolled member of the Bishop Paiute Tribe.
3. I am not married.
4. I am not pregnant nor have any children/dependents.
5. I am currently enrolled in high school or have obtained my High School Diploma/GED.
6. Residing in Inyo/Mono County

Other Requirements:

1. I will attend all pre-pageant meetings and events as scheduled (*dates/times TBD*).
2. I am not currently holding any other titles. *If less than 30 days from retiring a title, I must disclose for approval to compete for Miss Bishop Paiute Tribe.*
3. I have not previously held the title of Miss Bishop Paiute Tribe.
4. I am not currently on probation/parole.
5. If crowned, I will refrain from the use of alcohol and illegal substances during my reign.
