How Often Should Masks Cloth Masks Be Washed?

The CDC recommends washing your mask after each use, and you can wash it in a washing machine or by hand. If using a washing machine, don't be afraid to wash your mask along with your regular laundry and with standard laundry detergent and the warmest water the cloth material of your mask can handle.

When Should You Change Your Child's Mask?

Children's mask need to be changed after coughing, sneezing or when dampness happen within their mask. Disposable mask should be changed out regularly and cloth masks need to be washed daily. Disposable masks cannot be washed.
