

BISHOP PAIUTE TRIBAL COURTROOM POLICY

1) ABSOLUTELY NO WEAPONS OF ANY KIND.

By entering into the Courtroom you voluntarily consent to a search of yourself and belongings to include purses, backpacks, sacks, etc. If you do not consent or refuse to a search you will not be permitted into the Courtroom.

2) NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS.

Any individual who appears to be intoxicated or under the influence of a controlled substance, will be asked to leave the Courtroom. Anyone determined to be a threat to public safety, the Tribal Police will take necessary action. If you are a party to a court proceeding, your case will either proceed without you present or postponed.

3) ALL CELLPHONES MUST BE ON SILENT OR TURNED OFF.

4) ABSOLUTELY NO PHOTOGRAPHY, NO AUDIO OR VIDEO ALLOWED.

5) TALKING MUST BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM.

Those will young children disturbing a court hearing will be asked to step out of the Courtroom.

6) UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED ALL COMMENTS ARE TO BE DIRECTED TO THE PRESIDING JUDGE.

7) ANY VIOLATION MAY RESULT IN A CONTEMPT OF COURT CHARGE.
